Pastors Training with MINTS

One of our requirements for pastoral ordination is having a first degree in theology from a reputable institution. One of my responsibilities has been to prepare men on our pastoral team for ordination. This month we are starting a satellite center for MINTS to train men for pastoral ministry. This will be based at Mponela and two experienced pastors have agreed to assist me with this program. We will be meeting once a month for two days of course work. Eventually we might add more people and days depending on the progress.

Wilicks Laston Ordination

Wilicks Laston joined us in 2019 when he had finished his studies with Teen Missions program. It has been my joy to see what the Lord has been doing in his life spiritually as well as physically. He was among the first men who went through an informal training program I had developed using MINTS resources.

After sometime he joined a formal MINTS center in Lilongwe where I taught briefly to finish his degree program. He finished in 2022 and started pursuing his ordination process. He did his written exam and now awaits an oral exam before he gets ordained. His oral ordination exam will be on Saturday April 27th. If he passes the exam, his ordination has been scheduled for May 26th in Dzuwa our first church plant and where he is currently serving.



I am really excited to see this development in the life of our churches. It gives me joy to see other men who can take this work forward. Certainly the work of the Kingdom is like a mustard seed and it is so beautiful to see it grow.

MOM'S UPDATE

Mom and dad were denied USA visa and instead mom and my brother Timothy traveled to Kenya for surgery. Mom received a successful hip replacement surgery on Friday, March 15th. After spending the weekend in the hospital, she was discharged on Monday the 18th and has continued with daily physiotherapy. The follow-up appointment on the 28th showed good results with the wound healing well and a recommendation to continue physiotherapy until the next review.




The hospital asked to see her again on April 25th so she and Timothy will be staying in Kenya until that time. God willing, their return flight to Malawi will be on May 4th.

WESTMINSTER SEMINARY UPDATE

I am so thankful for this opportunity! However, it has surfaced another burden which I similarly experienced several years ago when I first began as a student at Westminster. I had to work in various capacities from gardening to serving as a youth pastor in order to help financially provide for my family. This added additional pressure to my schoolwork.

This year as I anticipate our move to resume my studies, I have mixed emotions and concerns regarding provision for our living expenses; but I am trusting the Lord to lead and provide. Our budget for the year is \$55,300. Currently Midway PCA in Georgia has provided us a \$3,000 support and we are so grateful. Our needs are now at \$52,300.
